



AlphaSync

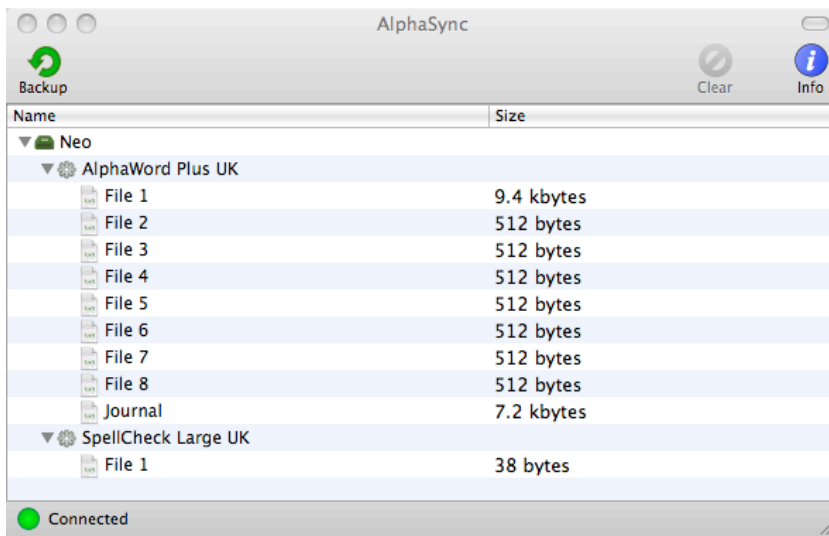
AlphaSync provides a fast drag-and-drop interface to get files on or off a Neo, emulating a simple filing system window.

AlphaSync has the following features:

- single click backup to copy all text files from the Neo to your Mac
- drag files from the Neo in to an application window to paste the text in to a document
- drag and drop text files between the Neo to the finder
- the ability to directly access named files as well as the standard eight file spaces
- very fast transfer speeds
- automatic startup of the application when a Neo is connected

AlphaSync is explicitly *not* a replacement for AlphaSmart Manager (ASM). You must still use ASM to load new applets, change applet settings, or work with applets other than AlphaWord and the user dictionary. AlphaSync will not modify the applets or settings on a device.

For information on using the application, see the built-in help.



Installation and removal

To install AlphaSync, simply copy the application to your local disk drive.

AlphaSync can be uninstalled by using the 'uninstall' menu option, described in the application help.
